Instructions for oral presentations

Each speaker is allocated a 20-minute slot, including time for questions/discussion. We kindly request that you aim to speak for a **maximum of 15 minutes** to allow approximately 3 minutes for questions. Due to the tight conference schedule, timing needs to be kept strictly by appointed chairs.

Presentations should be submitted via ConfTool by Monday, 17th March 2025 at the latest.

To submit your presentation, log into your ConfTool (https://www.conftool.com/safjr2025/) and click on Your Submissions in the main menu. There you will find the button Final Upload. We recommend to provide files in PDF format with all fonts embedded. Users of other programs such as Microsoft PowerPoint are requested to export their slides to PDF. In exceptional cases, we will also accept PowerPoint, but we cannot guarantee that the versions under which you prepared your talk and our version match. We therefore strongly recommend the PDF format. All necessary technical equipment (laptop, microphone/headset, laser pointer, etc.) will be provided at the conference venue.

If any changes need to be made to your presentation after submission, please e-mail the updated version before the morning of the conference to safjr2025@imbie.uni-bonn.de.

The conference program is also attached to this mail. Please refer to this program to determine the day and time of your allocated session in which your talk will take place.

As the conference is an opportunity for junior researchers to get an idea of current research being undertaken by their peers, please kindly ensure that all technical terms and mathematical formulas that exceed basic survival knowledge are clearly explained, and that your slides are easy to read and understand.
